

TOBACCO POLICIES SANTA CLARA

In Santa Clara County, 93% of retailers sell menthol tobacco products and 80% of tobacco retailers sell flavored, non-cigarette tobacco products such as: cigars, little cigars, smokeless tobacco, hookah tobacco, electronic smoking devices and e-liquid. Some of these retailers are located near schools.

**According to the "2019 Healthy Stores for a Healthy Community" survey data.*

The City is exploring an ordinance to prohibit the sale of flavored tobacco products within the city of Santa Clara. With this ordinance, the City would establish a tobacco retailer permit which would prohibit sales of flavored e-cigarettes, e-liquids, flavored cigars, little cigars, flavored hookah, and menthol cigarettes in Santa Clara.
